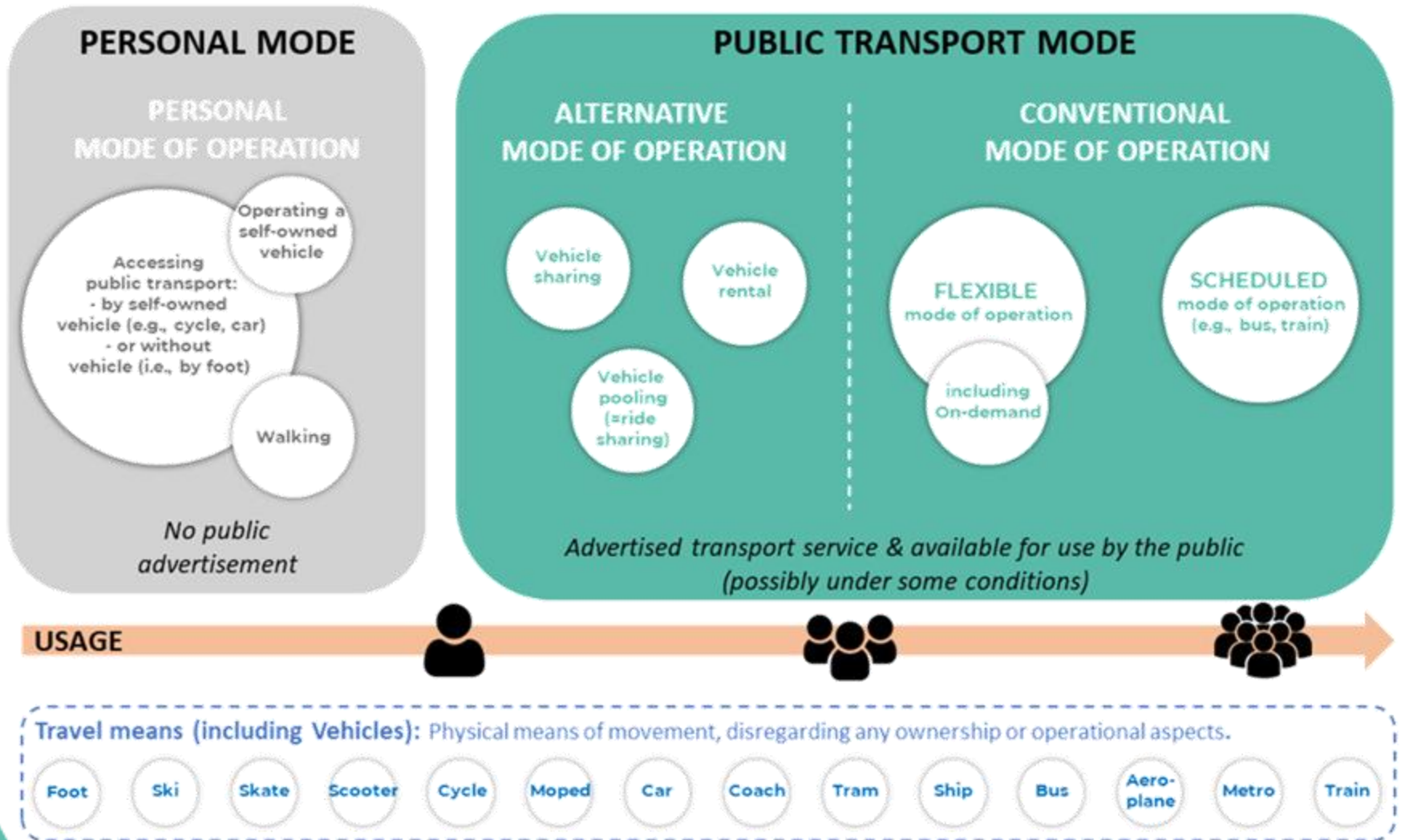

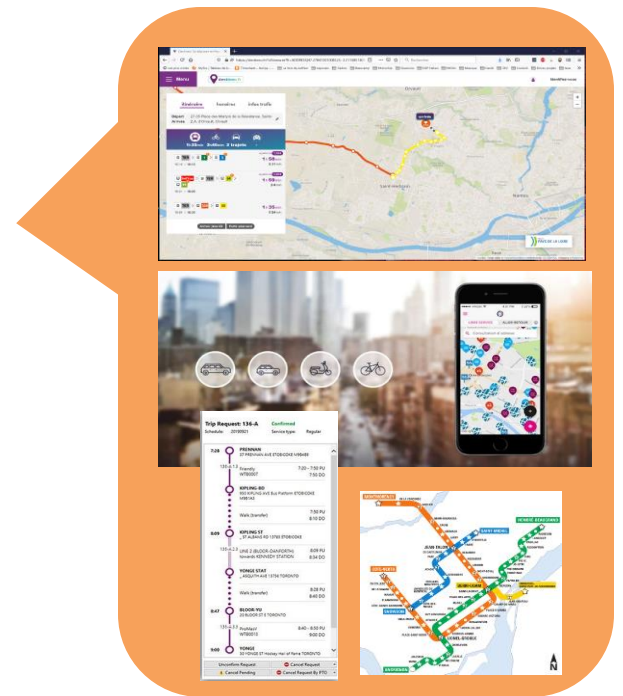
Passenger information AND operations

- NeTEx is not only about Passenger information



Passenger Information

Journey planner, displays, app & web sites





Passenger information AND operations

- It's also about service's operations

Mobility needs analysis and transport plan definition (Authorities)

Scheduling and production plan

Indicators and statistics

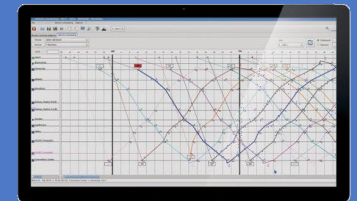
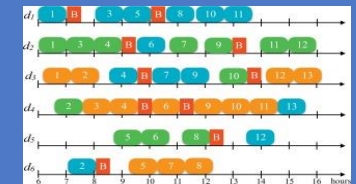
Fare offer and Ticketing

AVMS (Automated Vehicle Monitoring System)

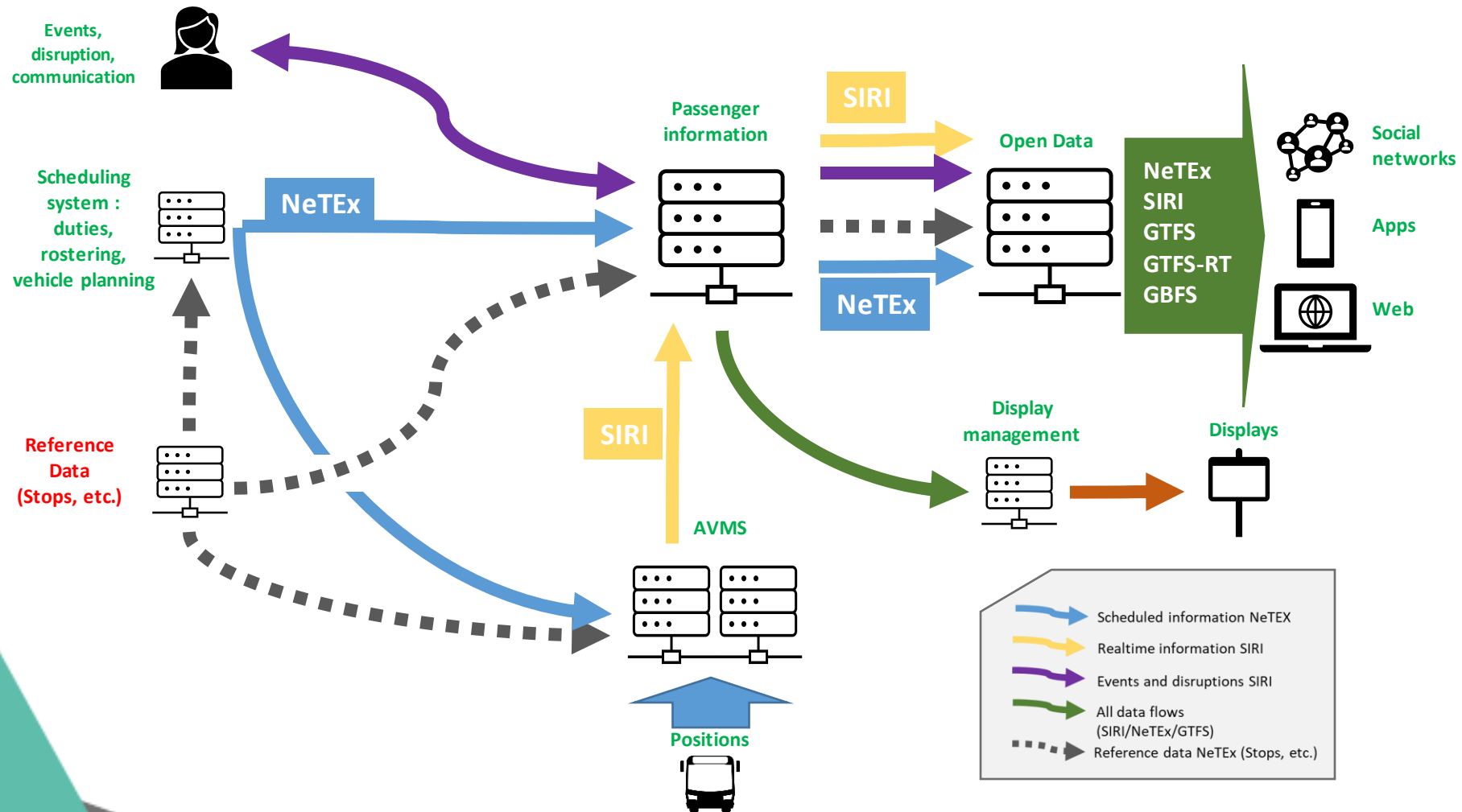
Analysis, BI, optimisation

Multiple scheduling systems (bus, tram, metro, multiple operators, etc.)

AVMS



Multiple Automated Vehicle Monitoring System (per mode and operator)



Additional accessibility information (scheduled and real-time)



Additional passenger counting information (estimated and real-time)

NeTEx (and SIRI)

- ✓ NeTEx (and SIRI) allow to have a single exchange protocol for all data flows instead of one for each couple of system (which can be A LOT of protocols)
- ✓ You most often lose something in data conversion ...
- ✓ It's important to avoid hacking existing protocol to carry new data... and NeTEx (and SIRI) have the wider coverage you can expect



NeTEx (and SIRI)

- ✓ The exchange protocol shall not be dependent on the providing/consuming system:
 - to allow system renewal, and an open choice of the provider
 - to strengthen the system against the politics or failure of providing companies





Conclusion

Transmodel (NeTEx, SIRI and more)
are not just tools to fulfill the EU
regulation.

They help to structure
and rationalise the systems involved in
mobilityservices!
